Yoga for Kids

Grades: PK-2 | \$160 (6 classes)

Swim Lessons

Grades: K-2 | \$110 (6 classes)

The students will investigate the unseen microscopic world. Interactive learning activities will include: making an edible cell, collecting and exploring samples from around the CA campus. Learning the fascinating world of microscopy often acts as a springboard for continued interest in science.

Young Chefs Academy: Down on The Farm

Join Young Chefs Academy in a six week session where we will be creating recipes inspired by farm life! Students will enjoy hands-on cooking including farm favorites like hay stacks, pigs in a blanket and moo juice.

Lacrosse

Grades: K-3 | \$100 (6 classes)

Instructor: JumpBunch

In this co-ed instructional lacrosse program, sessions will include 50% instruction and 50% game playtime. Participants will develop fundamentals of cradling, scooping, throwing, catching, passing, shooting, and the general rules of lacrosse in these highly active and engaging sessions. **Participants must provide their own lacrosse stick.** All other equipment will be provided.

LEGO Robot BattleBot Building and Programming

Grades: 3-6 | \$120 (6 classes)

Instructor: Robot Academy

Kids build and program LEGO Robots to compete in several BattleBot championships. Students learn to program BattleBots in the Mindstorms EV3 language using sensors and logic. Young engineers are introduced to mechanical design, programming and engineering concepts. No experience is necessary – we teach students everything they need to know to put together a winning BattleBot. Students in Girl Scouts will earn a STEM badge and Boy Scouts will earn the Robotics badge. Students do not need to be in Boy Scouts or Girl Scouts to take this class.

Students will also make their own first aid kit; make a model of the brain, and their own spine model.
